Inspection Summary

Inspection Conducted October 2 through December 20, 1989 (Report 50-313/89-38; 50-368/89-38)

<u>Areas Inspected</u>: Routine, unannounced inspection of the licensee's physical security program. The areas inspected within the physical security program included management effectiveness; records and reports; locks, keys, and combinations; vital area (VA) detection aids; and alarm stations.

<u>Results</u>: Within the areas inspected, no violations or deviations were identified. One open item is identified in paragraph 3. An unresolved item is identified in paragraph 6.

The licensee is making significant progress in establishing an improved security program. Multiple perimeter improvement projects are underway at this time. The licensee appears to have sufficient security officers, both armed ENCLOSURE CONTAINS

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and unarmed, to perform the tasks required at the present time. The licensed's training program for security officers appears to be improving and becoming more structured. Contract security supervisors are now receiving AP&L supervisory courses.

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
