This refers to the inspection conducted by L. T. Ricketson and B. Murray of this office during the period November 27 through December 1, 1989, of activities authorized by NRC Operating Licenses NPF-76 and NPF-80 for Units 1 and 2 of the South Texas Project, and to the discussion of our findings with members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.


Areas examined during the inspection included portions of your radiation protection program activities. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors. The inspection findings are documented in the enclosed inspection report.

During the inspection, it was found that certain of your activities were in violation of NRC requirements. However, in accordance with 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C, Section V.G.1 of the NRC's Enforcement Policy, no citation is being issued for the violation described in paragraph 9 of the enclosed inspection report.

We have also examined actions you have taken with regard to previously identified inspection findings. The status of these items is identified in paragraph 2 of the enclosed report.
