As we discussed last week, attached is the application for a second export license to ship this detector to Salazar Nuclear Center, under the IAEA referenced above. Reuter-Stokes requests that the Department of State in the NRC use the same letter of assurance as furnished to us by the Mexican purchaser as was used for the original license.

This fission chamber was originally sent, using license XCOM1010 on April 29, 1988. The chamber was damaged in shipment and returned to Reuter-Stokes. Since the original license expired in April, 1989, we are applying for a new license. This will permit shipment of an identical fission chamber.
