Dear Mr. Davis:

Daniel L. Sissors, Ph.D., the named Radiation Safety Officer for the above referenced NRC license, resigned his position with Imreg, Inc. effective 30 September 1988. At that time Richard D. Lasky, Ph.D. - Research Biochemist assumed the duties of the Radiation Safety Officer at the Imreg, Inc. Cambridge, Massachusetts facility. Additional information concerning Dr. Lasky is presented below:

Richard D. Lasky, Ph.D. Research Biochemist, has received formal training and experience with radiation protection and the biological effects of radiation. While at the University of California, Davis (1978-1983), Dr. Lasky became well versed in radioactive measurements, standardization, and monitoring in the course of his research which led to the Ph.D. degree in Biochemistry. During this time, his training included: (1) general characteristics of radiation and radioactive materials; (2) physical and chemical characteristics of radionuclides; (3) mathematics and calculations basic to the use and measurement of radioactivity including units of quantity of radioactivity and units of radiation dose and exposure; (4) the use of radiation instrumentation for measurements and monitoring including operating procedures, instrument calibration and instrument limitations; (5) proper procedures for documenting the usage and disposal of radionuclides.

Dr. Lasky continued his training in the principles and practices of handling all forms of biomedical research isotopes during his postdoctoral research at Massachusetts General Hospital and Harvard Medical School (1983-1985). At Massachusetts General, Dr. Lasky attended formal seminars and was certified in Basic Radiation Protection for Research and Hospital Personnel. Extensive formal training was also received at the University of California,

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
Berkeley, during post-doctoral research (1985-1987). Isotopes and quantities of isotopes handled included: H<sub>3</sub>-5mCi, C<sub>14</sub>-5mCi, P<sub>32</sub>-500uCi, and I<sub>125</sub>-100mCi. He has continued this use experience to the present time.

This correspondence is to request that NRC Material License Number 20-27876-01 be amended to reflect this change in Radiation Safety Officers. We have enclosed Imreg, Inc. Check Number 17354 in the amount of one hundred twenty (\$120) dollars as payment of the required amendment fee.
