

In support of their motion, Applicants state the following:

- 1. With regard to addressees Nadeau, Kensington Chairman, Powers, and Canney, these individuals and the entities that they represent have not actively participated in any of the Seabrook proceedings for at least several years. Indeed, with regard to most of the issues still pending before the various boards, these addressees have never participated.
- 2. The intervenors in these proceedings have not been including Nadeau, Kensington Chairman, Powers, and Canney in their more recent service lists. See, e.g., Certificate of Service accompanying Intervenors' Application for a Stay of LBP-89-32 (December 1, 1989).
- 3. Representatives for the Town of Exeter and the City of Portsmouth (i.e., the parties presently or formerly represented by addressees Power and Canney) have stated to Applicants that they do not object to being removed from the service lists.
- 4. Several recent mailings to addressee Nadeau have been returned as undeliverable.
- 5. With respect to addressee Lord, the entity for whom he appears as a representative, the Town of Amesbury, is already

being served through counsel, and so should not receive duplicate service.

6. With respect to all addresses, deletion of these names with shorten the lengthy service lists for these proceedings, and increase efficiency in filing and service for the active participants.
