SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION FROM 10 CFR 55.45(b)(2)(iii) FILING
DEADLINE (TAC NO. 75335)

Re: Perry Nuclear Power Plant

The staff is currently evaluating your request, dated November 21, 1989, for an exemption from the filing requirements of 10 CFR 55.45(b)(2)(iii) to allow for the submittal of NRC Form 474, "Simulation Facility Certification," after the March 26, 1991 deadline provided in the rule. The staff requires additional information to fully evaluate your request. Please provide the following items:

1. A description of the events and decisions, including approximate dates, which lead to the decision that your initial plans to upgrade your existing simulator were not feasible.
2. A description of your approach to determining your specific needs for your replacement simulator.
3. A description of the training which license candidates will receive on the new simulator prior to its use for the August 1991 examinations.

You are requested to provide this information within 15 days receipt of this letter. If you cannot meet this schedule, or if you have any questions on this matter, please contact me as soon as possible or (301) 492-1389.

The information requested in this letter affects fewer than 10 respondents; therefore OMB clearance is not required under Pub. L. 96-511.
