SUBJECT: MISSING Cs-137 CHECK SOURCE

Florida, an Agreement State, advised Region II on January 5, 1990 that a survey instrument check source containing 500 microcuries Cs-137 was determined to be missing from the Pan-American Hospital, Miami, Florida.

The check source was last accounted for on December 27, 1989 and was determined to be missing on January 5, 1990.

The State dispatched an inspector to investigate this matter. To date, the source has not been located.

The State is continuing its investigation of this matter and will keep Region II informed.
