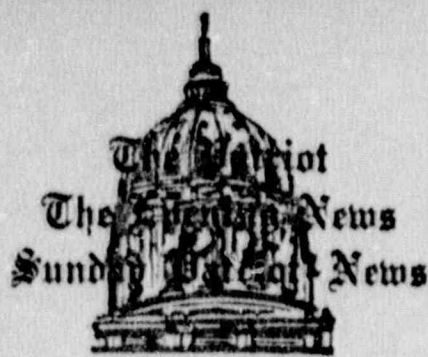

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Unit, I hereby request copies of all documents pertaining to the Sept. 25, 1989, exposure incident at the Three Mile Island nuclear plant near Middletown, Pa.

Two workers in the Unit 2 Decon Facility accidentally handled an object that turned out to be a lump of fuel from the damaged Unit 2 reactor. Both received serious exposure to radiation as a result.

I would like copies of all reports filed on the incident by GPU and NRC personnel, any reports on the medical consequences of the accident to the two workers, correspondence between the NRC and GPU Nuclear pertaining to the incident, and the transcript of the enforcement conference held regarding the incident on Nov. 17, as well as any reports or minutes pertaining to the conference.
