Gentlemen:

This refers to our January 11, 1990 telephone conversation regarding the disposition of your licensed radiography devices and response to the NRC Order Imposing Civil Penalties dated October 30, 1989.

Based upon this conversation, it is our understanding that you:

1. Have made arrangements to transfer your cobalt-60 and iridium-192 radiography sources currently in your possession to the Tech-Ops Corporation. This transfer is expected to occur within the next week pending receipt of the proper shipping containers from Tech-Ops. As was agreed upon, you will notify this office immediately by telephone when that transfer occurs.
2. Will fill out an NRC Form 314 (Request for License Termination) and submit it to this office once your radiography sources are transferred to Tech-Ops. Along with that termination request, you also stated that you will provide this office with a letter describing your intentions to comply with the NRC Order Imposing Civil Penalties and a response to our letter to you dated December 19, 1989. It is expected that this letter will be forwarded to our office without delay once your radiography sources have been transferred to Tech-Ops.

If your understanding differs from that set forth above, or if you are unable to transfer your sources to Tech-Ops within the anticipated time frame, please contact me or Bruce Mallett at (708) 790-5500.
