SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO BULLETIN 88-10 FOR ARKANSAS NUCLEAR ONE, UNITS 1 AND 2

On November 22, 1988, the NRC staff issued Bulletin 88-10, "Nonconforming Molded-Case Circuit Breakers, requesting certain actions to be taken in regard to molded-case circuit breakers (MCCB) used in safety-related applications. The bulletin requested that licensees provide a written response confirming that actions requested by the bulletin had been taken, summarizing the results of those actions and if not completed, a schedule for completion.

By letters dated March 31, October 31, and December 28, 1989, you responded to Eulletin 88-10. The NRC staff has completed the review of your responses and finds that your actions are in conformance with the bulletin. No further action is required at this time. The NRC staff considers that you have met the response requirements of Bulletin 88-10.

As discussed in Bulletin 88-10, you should maintain the documentation associated with this bulletin for at least five years. These records may be subject to inspection in the future.
