ANNUAL UPDATE TO THE RANCHO SECO QUALITY MANUAL (RSQM)

Attention: George Knighton

Submitted herewith in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(a)(3) is the annual update to the RSQM approved January 22, 1990. No changes made to the manual reduce the commitments in the RSQM previously accepted by the NRC.

Non-editorial changes included in this revision 5 to the RSQM, and the required reason for change and basis for concluding 10 CFR 50 Appendix B criteria are still met, are as follows:

- A) Changes throughout the RSQM to reflect current organization functions and titles of responsible positions.

Reason: Organization and responsibility changes found necessary during the past year.

Basis for Concluding Commitments Still Met: Requirements of the RSQM are not impacted by this change.

- B) Added effluent control and environmental monitoring to the scope of the RSQM.

Reason: Consolidation of quality functions.

Basis for Concluding Commitments Still Met: Previous requirements of the RSQM are not impacted by this change.

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- C) Eliminated reference to the CASE Registry of nuclear suppliers, which was discontinued.

Reason: Registry discontinued.

Basis for Concluding Commitments Still Met: Requirement placed on suppliers and plant departments remain as previously approved.

- D) Clarified the requirement for marking and labeling containers with the potential for causing contamination or radiation exposure to indicate need for special radiological controls.

Reason: Clarification

Basis for Concluding Commitments Still Met: No change to any commitment occurs due to this clarification.


