Gentlemen:

This is to confirm our telephone conversation on October 21, 1988, with yourself in which we discussed the information we need to continue review of your application dated September 6, 1988.

The items specified below are those we discussed.

1. Please designate one of the responsible individuals listed in your application as the Radiation Safety Officer for your program. This individual will be responsible for the maintenance of records required by the license and the regulations. Also, that person is responsible for seeing that all NRC rules and regulations are followed.
2. Please submit the manufacturer's name and model number for the Electron Capture Detector that you intend to purchase.
3. Please confirm the activity on the foil of the Electron Capture Detector.
4. Your request for a three year leak test interval will be considered upon submittal of the manufacturer's name and model number for the Electron Capture Detector.

If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter, we shall assume that you do not wish to pursue your application.
