

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

As a result of the inspection conducted on January 11, 1990, and in accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C, (1989) (Enforcement Policy) the following violation was identified:

Licensee Condition No. 17.A. requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in certain referenced documents.

The application dated February 27, 1989, states in Item 9.1 that the area designated "hot lab" will be used for receipt, storage, preparation, and measurement of radioactive material.

Contrary to the above, the area designated "hot lab" was not used for receipt of radioactive material. Specifically, since 1985, receipt of radioactive material has been in the lounge/meeting room area.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each violation: (1) the corrective steps that have been taken and the results achieved; (2) the corrective steps that will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
