the facility technical specifications pertaining to provisions to reset
instrument channels and/or trip systems, and to remove requirements to place
channels and/or trip systems in the tripped condition under certain circumstances.
However, your staff subsequently informed the NRC during a telephone conference
that the amendment is no longer requested. Therefore, your proposed change is
considered to be withdrawn. If this information is not correct, please notify
