QUESTION 8. Have decisions of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Appeal
Board ever before been overruled by the Atomic Safety and
Licensing Board? If yes, please provide a detailed
explanation of the circumstances and a justification that
addresses how this is consistent with the Administrative
Procedures Act, relevant statutes, and fundamental
fairness to the parties.

## ANSWER.

Without taking any position on whether in the Seabrook proceeding the Licensing Board has overruled an Appeal Board decision (to express any view would be inappropriate under the principles enunciated in <u>Pillsbury</u>, cited earlier), we are not aware of any instance in which a Licensing Board has "overruled" an Appeal Board decision.
