Add a) Cs-137; b) Sealed Source; c) Texas Nuclear Model 5200, 696894 Source Capsule; d) 20 mCi.

6. A Texas Nuclear Model 5200 Level Switch containing 20 millicuries of Cs-137 in a Texas Nuclear 696894 source capsule is to be installed on the Fresh Catalyst Loading Hopper (23-S-9).

This device will allow us to monitor the level of fresh catalyst that drops into the hopper from the fresh catalyst storage drum. The catalyst in the hopper is loaded into the process unit regenerator by a carrier air stream. The new level switch will allow us to automate this process.

The Loading Hopper is located in free air, outside of any structure, and is installed at grade level. Workers normally would visit the site several times a day to check on equipment operation.
