
Dear Mr. Wright:

We request amendment to our above referenced radioactive materials license to reflect the following:

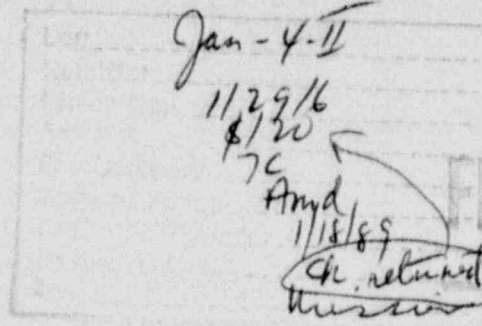
1. Our department will be expanding within the next few months. Please amend our license to reflect the expansion of our department. A new facility sketch is attached for your review.
2. Air flow rates will be determined in the new imaging room. The hot lab will be unchanged in it's location and will not be affected by the renovations. We will calculate the worker dose from Xenon-133, the public dose from airborne effluent, and the spilled gas clearance time for the department after the renovations are complete. These calculations will be on file for the NRC's review during inspections.
3. During renovations we wish to move one of our gamma cameras to a vacant room approximately 20 yards down the hall from our existing department. This will allow us to continue operations during renovations. We confirm that we will follow all radiation safety procedures the same as if this room was directly attached to our department. Radioactive material will be transported to this room in a leaded container. We will not use Xenon-133 in this room. Attached is a sketch of this temporary imaging room.

We hope that this information is sufficient to grant our request for amendment. Enclosed is a check in the amount of \$120.00 to cover the amendment processing fee. Thank you for your help with this amendment.
