### NRC STAFF MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME IN WHICH TO RESPOND TO DISCOVERY REQUEST

#### INTRODUCTION

During a prehearing conference on November 29, 1989, the Licensing Board adopted a schedule for the course of this proceeding to which the parties had agreed. The Board confirmed this schedule by order dated December 1, 1989. According to the schedule, the parties are to produce documents and respond to interrogatories on January 31, 1990. In responding to the USR companies' first document request, however, the staff has to date collected in excess of 3000 documents. Given the volume of documents that appear to be responsive to the USR companies' request, the staff requests three additional weeks in which to respond to the document request. Given the amount of time the staff has expended collecting and reviewing documents to respond to the interrogatories and document request, the staff also requests one additional week to respond to USR Industries' interrogatories. In view of the additional time needed to respond to these discovery requests, the staff also requests that the schedule for the further course of this proceeding be delayed by three weeks. USR Industries has

### MOTION

Wherefore, the NRC staff requests the Licensing Board to extend the time for responding to USR Industries' document request by three weeks, until February 21, 1990, and requests the Licensing Board to extend the time for responding to USR Industries' interrogatories by one week, until February 7, 1990. The NRC staff also requests that, in light of the delay in producing documents and answering interrogatories, the Licensing Board extend the rest of the schedule for this proceeding by three weeks. USR Industries has no objection to an extension as long as it applies to all parties. At the time of filing this motion, the NRC staff was unable to contact Mr. Jack Miller of Safety Light. The staff has no objection to the proposed extension applying to all parties.
