## Inspection Summary

Inspection Conducted November 13-17, 1989 (Report 50-458/89-39)
Areas Inspected: Routine, unannounced inspection of the licensee's physical security program. The areas inspected within the physical security program included records and reports, management effectiveness, assessment aids, physical barriers - protected area (PA), detection aids - PA, compensatory measures, testing and maintenance, communications, and security system power supply.

Results: Within the program areas inspected, three apparent violations were identified (inadequate detection aids - PA, inadequate compensatory measures, and inadequate assessment aids). Two unresolved items (security system battery test and records and reports) are identified in paragraphs 3 and 11.

The licensee security management staff is relatively new to RBS. The staff is capable of resolving the issues identified in this report. The licensee's audit program should have identified some of the apparent violations discussed in this report, especially that compensatory procedure contradicts the Physical Security Plan (PSP) requirements.
