Dear Mr. Martin:

By our letter of November 29, 1989 referenced above, we responded generally that for systems required for cold shutdown and the SAFSTOR decommissioning mode, Rancho Seco meets the requirements of Generic Letter 89-10 regarding safety-related motor-operated valve testing and surveillance. To supplement our previous general response, we are providing this additional information pertaining to the Generic Letter.

With the plant defueled, we have no safety-related motor-operated valves required to be OPERABLE in the current plant condition. As such, we consider the requirements of Generic Letter 89-10 to be no longer applicable to Rancho Seco.
