Dear Mr. Council:

This refers to and summarizes the inspection, a series of working meetings and document reviews conducted by Cordell C. Williams during the period of December 5, 1988 through January 27, 1990, of activities authorized by NRC construction permits CPPR-126 and CPPR-127 for the Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station (CPSES), Units 1 and 2, and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. C. B. Hogg and other members of your staff, at the conclusion of various elements of these examinations.

The enclosed inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. The inspection included follow-up of your implementation of ASME Section XI Repair and Replacement Program as related to the NIS-2/N-5 completion process. Review of your completion of the ASME Section XI, VT-2 Hydrostatic Test, follow-up of related ASME Code issues and review and documentation of other construction issues.

Within the scope of the inspection, no violations or deviations were identified. In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

As a result of these inspections, examinations and document reviews, the NRC staff has concluded that your implementation of the ASME Section XI modification, repair and replacement program (rerating activities) for CPSES Unit 1, as it relates to the development and completion of ASME Section XI NIS-2 Forms (Owner's Report of Repair or Replacement), has been sufficiently comprehensive and the records demonstrate that all requirements of the ASME Code have been met. Further, to the extent required, we note that the approximately 807 documentation packages associated with the ASME Section XI NIS-2 forms, are indexed and appropriately traceable to each of the ASME Section III N-5 documents for CPSES Unit 1 and common systems. The subject ASME N-5 forms were previously submitted to the Texas jurisdiction; the Texas Department of Labor and Standards, Boiler Division (now known as "Texas Department of Licensing and

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Regulation"). It is our understanding that the chief inspector State of Texas has also concluded that your activities to date in regard to this issue are in accordance with the ASME Code Sections III and XI for CPSES Unit 1 and common systems.

Should you have any questions concerning this inspection, we will be pleased to discuss them with you.
