SUBJECT: INSPECTION OF THE EMERGENCY OPERATING PROCEDURES

This letter is to formalize requests made in a conversation between Mr. Gary Buchard, of your staff, and Mr. Barry Norris on February 6, 1990, regarding a planned inspection of the Connecticut Yankee Atomic Power Plant Emergency Operating Procedures (EOPs) during the period of May 14 through 25, 1990. It is requested that the plant-referenced simulator be made available for evaluation of the effectiveness of the EOPs as part of the inspection.
