Regarding CILRT Scheduling

Attached is a proposed change to Technical Specifications, and corresponding request for exemption From 10CFR 50 Appendix J, for a one-time request for relief from the requirement that the third of three Containment Integrated Leak Rate Tests (CILRTs) which are required during each unit's 10-year In-Service Inspection (ISI) interval must be performed during the same outage as the ISI. As discussed in the justification of the proposed change (see Attachment II) the need for this revision was caused by a scheduling anomaly and conflicting requirements as applied to this circumstance.

Note that this request is for a one-time change for the first ISI of Unit 1. As shown in the proposed schedule given in Attachment II, the third CILRT of the second 10-year ISI interval will be performed during the second ISI outage. Unit 2 is on schedule to perform the third CILRT of the first ISI interval during the ISI outage.
