We have received your letter dated January 24, 1990, regarding the regulation violation issue of our radiation safety program. This letter presents Dames & Moore's action to ensure that the radiation safety program in the Chicago office meets the requirements stated in "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions", 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C (1989).

Violation Issue - 10 CFR 150.20 (b)(1) requires that, when engaging in activities in non-agreement states under the general license granted by 10 CFR 150.20 (a), four copies of Form NRC-241 and four copies of the Agreement State specific license be filed with the Director of the appropriate Nuclear Regulatory Commission office at least three days prior to engaging in such activity.

Action - We appreciate your assistance in sending out two copies of Form NRC-241 and the List of Agreement States. With this information, we can follow the requirements of 10 CFR 150.20 (b)(1) in addition to contacting the governing authority of the nonagreement states.

With the provided Form NRC-241, we have already implemented this procedure in our radiation safety program as of January 31, 1990, and the Nuclear Safety Officer is fully aware of the identification of agreement and nonagreement states. The subject violation will not happen again.

We would like to thank Mr. Walter T. King for his helpful answers to the questions we had regarding the regulations. If you have any questions or require additional clarification regarding our compliance action, please call.
