As you may be aware, the Department of Energy (DOE) is currently developing a National Energy Strategy. In the words of Admiral Watkins, Secretary of Energy, "This strategy will serve as a blueprint for energy policy and government program decisions. It will contain specific short-term, midterm, and long-term recommendations. This strategy will chart our course, set our pace, and provide mileposts by which to evaluate our progress."
