Enclosed for your information are copies of a Director's Decision, letier of transmittal, Federal Register Notice, and NUREG-1285, "Reed Repor $q^{\prime \prime}$ issued by the Director, office of Nülear Reactor Regulation in response to a Petition filted under 10 CFR 2.206 of the Commission's regulations. The Petition was filed by Ws. Anna Harlowe on behalf of the Ecology Center of Southern California.

The petitioner requested that the NPC ifx or close all nuclear power reaciors designed by General Eleciric Company (GE). As discussed in the enclosed Director's Decision, the petitioner's request under 10 CFR 2.206 has been denied.
The petitionter also expressed concern that $G E$ is pursuing a "standardized" Rdvanced Boiling Vater Reactor design which petitioner alleges fails to address many of the shortconings identified by GE's own engineers as far Dack as the 1975 Reed Report. The petitioner was informed that the staff has not yet completed its safety evaluation for advanced bolling water reactor designs, nor has any utility applied for a license to butid or operate an advanced boiling water reactor.
