Gentlemen:

Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit Nos. 1&2
Security Program

Reference (1) forwarded the results of the NRC audit of the Millstone Nuclear Power Station Security System conducted in June and July of this year. The scope of this audit did not include the attachment to the Millstone Modified Amended Security Plan (MASP) that was forwarded by reference (2). The attachment to the MASP indicates measures which were taken to compensate for certain features of the MASP which could not be implemented by February 23, 1979 and the estimated schedule to implement those features. It was pointed out in reference (2) that the dates of implementation were dependent upon key items controlled by others, such as the delivery of materials and operability of complex hardware. This letter was followed by others on June 19, 1979, October 19, 1979 and May 12, 1980 to provide periodic updates on progress and revised schedules based upon items controlled by others. The report of the audit of June and July 1980 is therefore somewhat misleading as to the degree of severity of non-compliance items as the report did not take into account the applicable compensatory measures.




