### COMMENTS ON POINT BEACH GUARD TRAINING PLAN

A review of the plan reflects that it requires extensive revision prior to its becoming an acceptable document.

#### Chapter 1

Chapter 1 of the plan must commit to meeting all of the requirements of Part 73 Appendix B.I.A-G.

Delete all references to the Point Beach Nuclear Plant Modified Amended Security Plan (MASP). The guard training requirements under Part 73 Appendix B completely replace the requirements of the now obsolete Regulatory Guide 5.20.

#### Chapter 2

Chapter 2 of the plan must commit to meeting all of the requirements of Part 73 Appendix B.II.A-D.

This chapter must also include measurable and observable crucial guard functions, duties and associated training that the security force members receive. It is recommended that NUREG-0674, Security Personnel Training and Qualification Criteria, be used for determining what the NRC considers the minimum information that will be considered acceptable.

Delete all references to the MASP within this chapter.

## Chapter 3

Chapter 3 of the plan must commit to meeting all of the requirements of Part 73 Appendix B.III.A.

Delete all references to the MASP within this chapter.

## Chapter 4

Chapter 4 of the plan must commit to meeting all of the requirements of Part 73 Appendix B.IV.A-D.

## Chapter 5

Chapter 5 of the plan must commit to meeting all of the requirements of Part 73 Appendix B.V.A. 4 and 5.

Delete all references to the MASP within this chapter.
