Dear Mr. Winegrad:

In our December 17, 1979 letter responding to your November 6, 1979 inquiry regarding the effects of radioactive releases from the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, we committed to send you a copy of the Safety Evaluation supporting expansion of the spent fuel pool capacity when our review was completed. Due to administrative changes at the NRC, we overlooked our commitment until a recent review of the files.

Enclosed is a copy of the amendment package, including the Safety Evaluation for our authorization of an increase in the spent fuel pool storage capacity of both Calvert Cliffs units from 1056 to 1760 tuel assemblies. This package was issued September 19, 1980.

I apologize for any inconvenience our delay in meeting our commitment may have caused.
