SUBJECT: RFPA'S NEEDED FOR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TASK ORDERS ON THE CONOCO PROJECT

You are requested to issue two RFPA's on task orders related to the Conoco project review. The first RFPA is necessary to extend the period of performance and change the NRC Project Officer on the Colorado State University (CSU) Tailings Management-Long Term Stability review, FIN B7306. The present contract expiration date is February 20, 1981. Due to higher priority work the Project Officer has been unable to make progress on this review. Therefore, the project is being reassigned; the new Project Officer should be Linda J. Peck. A ninety day extension to the period of performance will be necessary. In addition, the contractor made a site visit which was not included in the original scope of work. Although the contractor did not follow proper procedures in terms of having this approved prior to the trip, the undertaking was beneficial to the NRC and would have been approved if proper notification had been given. (This additional site visit was necessary due to a severe storm at the time of the original site visit which prohibited the contractor from accomplishing the objective of the visit.) Therefore, it is requested that the Statement of Work for this task order be modified to provide for this second site visit and the costs associated with it which amount to \$275.

The second RFPA requested is simply to change the NRC Project Officer on FIN B7308-1 with Ott Water Engineers, Evaluation of Surface and Groundwater Impacts related to the proposed Conoco project. The need for this action is as stated above and, again, the new Project Officer should be Linda Peck.
