Dear Commissioner Ahearne:

Your attention is invited to the Freedom of Information Act [5 U.S.C. 552], as amended, and to implementing Nuclear Regulatory Commission instructions and regulations.

Under provisions of the above cited authority, request that we be provided with copies of the following documents:

1. Memoranda, correspondence and other written documentation constituting final reports of investigation, or similar determinations, of the causes and sources of radiation exposures suffered by licensed users of radioactive devices in Oklahoma during the past year.
2. Memoranda, correspondence and other written documentation constituting final reports of investigation, or similar determinations, of the radiation exposure suffered by Douglas Crofut, of Henryetta, Oklahoma, circa January 1981, if not encompassed by No. 1 above.

We are willing to provide reimbursement for reproduction costs, but request waiver of all fees, under NRC guidelines, since release of the information would be in the public interest.


