## Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 40, Source Material License SUB-1010 is hereby amended to authorize the use of hay grown on the test site as described in your application dated January 19, 1981, provided that the hay contains no more than 1.0 pCi/gm Ra-226, 0.25 pCi/gm Th-230 or 2.5  $\mu\text{gm/gm}$  U measured on a dry basis.

All other conditions of this license shall remain the same.

Your Mr. William Shelley agreed to the limitations in this license amendment in a telephone conversation with our Mr. Nixon on February 18, 1981.
