TRESPASSING

At approximately 7:00 p.m., May 6, 1981 an individual, escaping from an robbery that took place in Central Square in Cambridge, Mass., took refuge in a building outside of the designated restricted area boundary of the MIT Reactor Research Facility. Local authorities were in pursuit of the individual and followed the suspect to the building complex that is adjacent to the reactor building. The campus police aided the local authorities in the subsequent arrest of the unarmed suspect. Neither the barrier of the restricted area nor the reactor building were compromised.

Media interest is expected. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts has been notified. No press release is planned by either the licensee or the NRC at this time.

The IAT has been advised.

This Preliminary Notification is issued for information only and no further action by IE is anticipated.
