



Dear Bill:

This letter is in connection with NIPSCO's production yesterday, at the Bailly site, of a number of documents in response to Porter County Chapter Intervenor's Second Request to NIPSCO for Production of Documents and Porter County Chapter Intervenor's Third Request to NIPSCO for Production of Documents. As you and I had agreed beforehand, we designated those documents which we desired to take back to Chicago for further inspection and copying.

After we had designated all documents which we desired to take with us, we were informed by Russell Bohn that, at your direction, we would not be allowed to take with us those documents which had been segregated by NIPSCO personnel and placed in a box marked "Box 10". As I understand it, the sole basis for your refusal to permit us to take the documents with us is the possibility that others (either Public Service Company of Indiana or General Electric Company) may treat some of the information in them as proprietary.

Having produced those documents, NIPSCO cannot now withhold them from our further inspection and copying. They were part of a larger group of documents, all of which you informed us were responsive to our requests. It was



If we do not hear from you by Friday, May 8, we will have no choice but to ask the Board to order NIPSCO to furnish those documents to us.
