Subject: Inspection 81-01

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. Stearns of this office on May 29, 1981 of activities authorized by NRC License Nos. 29-05357-04 and 29-05357-05 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Stearns with Dr. Walradt of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection, and to a subsequent telephone discussion between Dr. Withycombe of your staff and Mr. Stearns on June 4, 1981.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your licenses as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your licenses. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.
