CONSUMERS FOWER COMPANY Docket 50-155 Request for Change to the Technical Specifications License DPR-6

For the reasons hereinafter set forth, it is requested that the Technical Specifications contained in the Facility Operating License DPR-6, Docket 50-155, issued to Consumers Power Company on May 1, 1964, for the Big Rock Point Plant be changed as described in Section I below:

I. Changes

A. Section 6.5.1.7

Change Paragraph 6.5.1.7.c by replacing the word "immediate" with "within 24 hours."

B. Section 6.5.2.1

Change the referenced edition of ANSI N18.7 from "1972" to "1976."

C. Section 6.7.1

Change Paragraph 6.7.1.b by replacing the word "immediately" with "within 1 hour."

Change Paragraph 6.7.1.d by replacing the words "10 days" with "14 days."

D. Section 6.8.1

Add the specific edition used of ANSI N18.7 such that the last sentence ends "...ANSI N18.7-1976."

<u>NOTE</u>: Revised Technical Specifications pages are attached. All changes, including those requested herein and by our February 16, 1981 submittal, are denoted by a vertical line in the right margin.

II. Discussion

The above proposed Technical Specifications changes are requested as a result of the NRC staff review of our Technical Specifications Change Request dated February 16, 1981. The above changes denoted as A. and C. are being made to achieve greater conformity with the Standard Technical Specifications. The above changes denoted as B. and D. are being made to update our usage of ANSI N18.7 to the 1976 edition and specifically, identify the applicable edition for Section 6.8.1. Our updating to the ANSI N18.7-1976 edition for Section 6.5.2.1 is based on the NRC staff acceptance of our positions with respect to Sections 4.3.1(5) and 4.3.4(3) of ANSI N18.7-1976 edition. Our positions are as follows:

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Section

- 4.3.1(5) SARB will not specifically contain an individual knowledgeable in Nondestructive Tosting (NDT) but will use consultants to perform this function as determined necessary by the SARB chairman.
- 4.3.4(3) SARB will not rereview Technical Specifications changes after NRC approval prior to implementation. Our basis for this position is that SARB reviews all Technical Specifications change requests prior to submittal to the NRC.

III. Conclusions

Based on the foregoing, both the Big Rock Point Plant Review Committee and the Safety and Audit Review Board have reviewed these changes and find them acceptable.
