This is in response to your letter of June 11, 1981, wherein you requested that the Coalition for Safe Power (CFSP) be placed on the NRC distribution list to receive copies of all documents, correspondence, etc. relating to the Trojan Nuclear Plant.

Your request comes at a time when NRC is making a concerted effort to reduce mailing costs. Adding CFSP to our distribution list for all Trojan-related documents would add substantial and unnecessary costs considering the close proximity of the Trojan local public document room (LPDR) to your office. The Trojan LPDR was recently moved from St. Helens to Portland to better serve the greater number of people and groups interested in the regulatory activities at Trojan.


