The Commission discussed the subject paper without taking final action.

The Commission requested that staff delete the last sentence of the first full paragraph on page 4 of the proposed Federal Register Notice (Attachment A to SECY-81-317). (EDO) (SECY Suspend: 6/17/81)

The Commission also requested that OGC, in coordination with EDO, provide an analysis in support of the proposed rulemaking, using existing materials, of the consequences of not allowing a completed nuclear plant to operate and a general conclusion whether these consequences could likely be outweighed by other environmental considerations. (See the discussion of this proposal on page 3 of SECY-81-317A.) (OGC/EDO) (SECY Suspend: 6/15/81)

The staff should insert appropriate language in the notice of proposed rulemaking. (EDO) (SECY Suspend: 6/17/81)
