Haddam Neck Plant Masonry Wall Design

In Reference (1), the NRC Staff requested that Connecticut Yankee Atomic Power Company (CYAPCO) provide information concerning the design and construction of concrete masonry walls at the Haddam Neck Plant.

CYAPCO reported in Reference (2) that the reevaluations performed in accordance with the criteria presented in Reference (3) had been completed. The resulting modifications to the concrete masonry walls at the Haddam Neck Plant have been completed with the exception of one wall located in the Turbine Building, designated as CYTB-1008. This wall was originally included in the listing of masonry walls provided as Attachment 1 to Reference (4), however, it was inadvertantly omitted during the design stage for the walls requiring modifications. CYAPCO, in conjunction with our consultant, is currently evaluating the wall to determine what type of modifications are necessary. Following this determination, the required design will be obtained from our consultant and the modifications will be implemented. CYAPCO conservatively estimates the modifications to CYTB-1008 will be completed by September 1, 1981.

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No Technical Specification requirements or action statements are applicable. A final report will be docketed upon completion of the modifications. We trust you find this information satisfactory.
