Dear Mr. Flack:

On September 25, 1980, you requested on behalf of Georgians Against Nuclear Energy (GANE) that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission reconsider its decision to issue construction permits to Georgia Power Company for the construction of the two Vogtle nuclear facilities. As a basis of its request, GANE cited an electricity demand forecast submitted by GPC to the Georgia Public Service Commission. According to GANE, this forecast indicates that upon completion of the two Vogtle facilities, GPC will have greater excess reserve generating capacity than was originally anticipated in the initial construction permit proceeding. GANE asserts that this information regarding excess capacity constitutes new information not previously considered by the NRC.

GANE's petition has been treated under 10 CFR § 2.206 of the Commission's regulations. Upon review of GANE's filings and of other relevant information, I have determined to deny the request. The reasons for this decision are fully discussed in the enclosed "Director's Decision under 10 CFR § 2.206." Also enclosed is a copy of a Federal Register Notice regarding this decision that is being filed with the Office of the Federal Register.

A copy of this decision will be placed in the Commission's Public Document Room at 1717 H Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20555 and at the Burke County Library, 4th Street, Waynesboro, Georgia 30830. A copy will also be filed with the Secretary for the Commission's review in accordance with 10 CFR § 2.206 (c) of the Commission regulations.
