Dear Dr. Williams:

In your letter of July 4, 1981, you inquired as to whether your "mimeographed inputs" would be considered by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in the event that Westinghouse Electric Corporation should apply, in the future, for a special nuclear material license for the ANFFP facility.

It is the understanding of the NRC Staff that Westinghouse Electric Corporation intends to file a motion to dismiss the present proceeding after the pending request to withdraw its application has been granted. In the event that Westinghouse should decide to apply for an SNM license for the ANFFP facility after the present proceeding has been dismissed, a notice of opportunity for hearing would have to be filed and a new proceeding would be instituted upon the filing of a proper petition for leave to intervene. Documents which had been filed in a prior proceeding -- such as your mimeographed materials -- would not automatically become part of the record in such a newly instituted proceeding, but would have to be re-filed.
