I. SECY-81-309 - Significant Changes Decision in Summer Antitrust Matter
(Adjudicatory Issue)

The Commission, by a vote of 4-0*, approved a modified order which denied the Central Electric Power Cooperative, Inc., petition for an affirmative "significant changes" determination under Section 105c(2) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954.

*Section 201 of the Energy Reorganization Act, 42 U.S.C. §5841, provides that action of the Commission shall be determined by a 'majority vote of the members present.' Commissioner Ahearne was not present when this item was affirmed, but had previously indicated his approval of the order. Had Commissioner Ahearne been present, he would have affirmed his prior vote. Accordingly, the formal vote of the Commission was 3-0 in favor of the decision.
