We are in the process of completing transactions involving the importation to the U.S. of the following enriched uranium (nominal values):

The enriched uranium is contained in acceptable type 30B UF6 cylinders. Actual transport will be handled by Edlow International.

The enriched uranium is presently owned by Gemeinschaftskernkraftwerk Tul r ffeld (GKT), Postfach 477, Marc Aurel-Strasse 4, A-10111 Vienna 1, Austria. It was originally provided under DOE Enrichment Services contract UES/AU 100 for use in fueling the GKT power reactor and is currently stored at Reactor Brennelement Union GmbH (RBU), at Hanau, Federal Republic of Germany.

The subject material will be purchased and imported to the United States by the SWUCO Inventory Storage Company (SISCO), a wholly owned subsidiary of the Separative Work Unit Corporation (SWUCO). The material will then be delivered in accordance with the date listed in the above table to a DOE gaseous diffusion plant for use as feed. Please note that the 2650 KgU, 2.39% enriched, must be delivered to DOE as feed in September, 1981.
