



Dear Mr. Stello:

This letter is in reference to the Notice of Violation issued by your office on June 1, 1981, citing Grandview Hospital of Dayton, Ohio for several infractions. In accordance with instructions set forth in Appendix A, I called your office this morning and spoke with Dudley Thompson to request an extension of the time permitted for both the Appeal of and Response to the Notice of Violation. Some of the key hospital personnel have been on vacation, and we need their input in order to prepare our Response. We are also awaiting some information being set to us by your office, which we need in order to research and prepare our Appeal.

We are requesting a 30-day extension, which would push the due date for both the Response and Appeal back to July 31, 1981. Mr. Thompson seemed to feel that there would be no problem in granting our request.
