Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 40 and your submittal dated March 31, 1981, License Condition No. 27 of Source Material License SUA-1354 is hereby revised to read as follows:

- 27. The licensee shall provide for stabilization and reclamation of the uranium recovery operation and facility decommissioning as described in the licensee's "Plan for Decommissioning of the Uranium Recovery Circuit", submitted by letter dated March 31, 1981, subject to the following modifications:
 - A. Any facilities or equipment which are not decontaminated to below the guidelines set forth in Annex A to this license, "Guidelines for Decontamination of Facilities and Equipment Prior to Release for Unrestricted Use or Termination of Licenses for Byproduct, Source or Special Nuclear Material", dated November 1976, shall be disposed of offsite at a licensed radioactive waste disposal facility or uranium mill tailings disposal facility.
 - B. Any evaporation pond, evaporation pond liner or soil under the evaporation pond which cannot be decontaminated to below the standards in the "Final Generic Environmental Impact Statement on Uranium Milling", NUREG-0706, Volume III, Appendix J, dated September 1980, shall be disposed of offsite at a licensed radioactive waste disposal facility or uranium mill tailings disposal facility.
 - C. The licensee shall develop and implement a program for revegetation of disturbed areas which shall be incorporated as a part of the decommissioning and reclamation plan.

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- D. The licensee shall submit, as part of the decommissioning plan, appropriate financial arrangements which shall address the following items: (1) a cancellation clause allowing at least 90 days from the beneficiary's certified receipt of surety's intent to cancel; (2) a statement that proof of forfeiture shall not be necessary to collect; and (3) specific cost estimates which reflect costs for meeting the above requirements A, B and C of this condition and contractor costs. Revised surety arrangements shall be submitted to the NRC by September 1, 1981, for review and approval through license amendment.

All other conditions of this license shall remain the same.

The effect of this amendment is to incorporate Brush Wellman Incorporated "Plan for Decommissioning of the Uranium Recovery Circuit", dated March 31, 1981, into Source Material License SUA-1354 with modifications, and to require the submittal for review of revised surety arrangements by September 1, 1981.
