

Docket 70-8; Request for an Amendment to SNM-7

This is a formal request for an amendment to SNM-7 to provide for a conditional exemption from requirements of 10 CFR Part 70.

This action is requested to more properly reflect our current and foreseeable inventory requirements at a level of less than one effective kilogram of unirradiated SNM. Our inventory under SNM-7 has remained below one effective kilogram of unirradiated SNM for the past three years. We anticipate no foreseeable change in our research operations that would require an inventory in excess of one effective kilogram of unirradiated SNM.

We request an amendment to SNM-7 that would provide for:

- Specifically exempt from the requirements of 10 CFR Part 70 for operations conducted at a level of less than one effective kilogram of unirradiated SNM, and
- (2) Prior to conducting operations at a level in excess of one effective kilogram a formal plan in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR Part 70 would be submitted for Commission approval.
