This refers to the routine, safety inspection conducted by Mr. J. Nicolosi of this office on June 18, 1981 of activities authorized by NRC License No. 37-17534-01 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Nicolosi ; th Mr. Hess of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examina ion of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.
Based on conversations at the conclusion of the inspection, it is our understanding that you will evaluate your security system for prevention of access to licensed materials to ensure adequate compliance with 10 CFR 20.207. This matter will be reviewed during our next inspection.
