Gentlemen:

Thank you for your letter dated June 29, 1981, informing us of the steps you have taken to correct the noncompliance which we brought to your attention in our letter dated June 8, 1981.

This letter also refers to the telephone conversation between Mr. Charles Neubauer of your organization and Mr. W. P. Reichhold of my staff concerning your corrective actions. It is our understanding that your corrective actions included or will include the following:

1. You will perform a weekly review of all survey results to ensure that the surveys have been performed and that the radiation levels do not exceed the allowable limits.
2. The extra bottles of krypton-85 gas have been returned to the supplier to ensure that the possession limit does not exceed five curies. An amendment to your license will be submitted to ensure that this limit will not be exceeded in the future.
3. A daily check of the posting in the storage area will be performed to ensure that the posting is adequate. Additional signs have been purchased for replacements if required.
4. Mr. Charles Neubauer and Mr. Jon Cokefair will review the shipping papers before shipment of radioactive materials to ensure that the proper transport index and the shipper's certification have been recorded.




