I. Article II - Period of Performance, is revised to read as follows:

"The period of performance under this contract is from July 20, 1981 through February 22, 1985."

II. Article III - Consideration and Payment, is revised to read as follows:

"Article III - Consideration and Payment

In full consideration of the contractor's presentation of the following courses, NRC shall pay the contractor the sums delineated below in accordance with Article-7 of the General Provisions entitled 'Payments.'

- A. Electrical Technology and Codes Course (October 5-23, 1981) \$50,000.00
- B. Instrumentation Technology and Codes Course (November 9-20,1981) \$50,000.00

Payment shall be made on a per course basis at the completion of each course. The NRC shall render payment to the contractor in approximately thirty (30) days after receipt of proper and correct invoices or vouchers."

III. Article V - <u>Key Personnel</u>, is revised to include the addition of the names of the following individuals:

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IV. Article VII - Project Officer, is revised to include the addition of the name of the following individual:

> "Edwin F. Fox, Jr. of the NRC's Office of Inspection and Enforcement is hereby designated as the Contracting Officer's Project Officer (PO) for the technical espects of this contract."

V. Article IX - <u>Travel Reimbursement</u>, is deleted in its entirety and the following new Article IX is added:

"Article IX - Travel Reimbursement

The contractor will be reimbursed for the following reasonable domestic travel costs incurred directly and specifically in the performance of this contract and accepted by the Contracting Officer:

- 1. Per diem shall be reimbursed at a daily rate not to exceed \$50.00. The per diem amount is comprised of lodging expense plus \$23.00 for meals and miscellaneous expense.
- 2. The cost of travel by privately owned automobile shall be reimbursed at the rate of 22.5¢ per mile.
- The cost of travel by rented automobile shall be reimbursed on a reasonable actual expense basis.
- 4. All common carrier travel reimbursable hereunder shall be via economy class rates when available. If not available, reimbursement vouchers will be annotated that economy class accommodations were not available. First-class air travel is not authorized.
- Receipts are required for common carrier transportation, lodging and miscellaneous items in excess of \$15.00."

VI. A new Article XI is added as follows:

"Article XI - Option for Additional Courses

This contract has an option for the presentation of additional courses in Electrical and Instrumentation Technology and Codes Courses as described in Article I - Statement of Work. The consideration to be provided the contractor for performance of the work set forth in this option shall be in accordance with contractor's proposal dated October 17, 1980, as amended. The date are as follows:

- A. Electrical Technology and Codes Course
 - 1. January, 1982 (Tentative)
 - 2. January, 1983 (Tentative)
 - 3. January, 1984 (Tentative)
 - 4. January, 1985 (Tentative)
- B. Instrumentation Technology and Codes Course
 - 1. February, 1982 (Tentative)
 - 2. February, 1983 (Tentative)
 - 3. February, 1984 (Tentative)
 - 4. February, 1985 (Tentative)

This option shall be exercised by the Contracting Officer who will provide notice of same to the contractor in writing sixty (60) days prior to the scheduled date for presentation of the course.

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It is expressly understood and agreed by the parties hereto that regardless of custom and usage in adminstration of this contract, only the Contracting Officer may give notice exercising the option as prescribed by this ARTICLE."
