The meeting began with a presentation by R. T. Woolsey of the WMUR staff's proposed license conditions which had been prepared to cover deficiencies in the applicants submission. H. J. Pettengill provided WMJR's operational safety philosophy and the rationale for certain of the conditions presented.
